


## Why does Switzerland need more health literacy?

Health is our most important asset and we must take responsibility for maintaining it. We usually only do this when we fall ill. «Health» is one of the megatopics of our time, which is also reflected in the increasing number of media reports, TV shows, new trends, apps, seminars, etc.

People with higher health literacy suffer less and recover faster if they are ill. They are in better health and help to reduce today's steadily increasing health costs. This is confirmed by studies and the federal expert report.

European surveys show: The Swiss population has poorer health literacy than the average European. It even lags behind countries such as Poland or Greece. We want to change this with MAX & EVE.





### Goals

**Strengthening health literacy:** As early as 2020, we will start various sustainable and long-term projects to strengthen health literacy in schools & everyday life throughout Switzerland.

- → To motivate people to take personal responsibility: Personal responsibility is the key to well-functioning health care. With various projects we want to encourage people to become more responsible for their own health.
- → World of experience: The projects culminate in 2023 in a major national world of experience on the theme of people. Playfully experiencing, making new discoveries, being right in the middle of the action as an effective means of promoting self-competence.
- → For everyone: People with disadvantages due to their social status, education, income, etc. are increasingly lacking in health literacy and are ill more often and for longer periods. We also want to support them in their self-competence.

## An innovative "hands-on" project

Through various projects MAX & EVE want to enable people of all ages to experience how their own body's processes work and how they are affected by social & environmental influences. In 2023 the projects will culminate in a national world of experience.

We take innovative new paths, bring visitors right into the middle of the action and choose a user-centered approach in the design of the exhibits. Research, everyday life and the inclusion of the environment are presented in equal measure.


The topics are geared to different categories of knowledge and age. Playing, touching, hearing, smelling, seeing, trying out, reading, so that young and old, intellectuals and those eager for experience benefit equally.



### MAX & EVE for schools

Special programs and experiments are being set up for schools, which can be used in the adventure park as well as in schools. Barrier-free infrastructure for the disabled is as much a part of the concept as is the provision of recreation and relaxation zones during the eventful day. Through various projects MAX & EVE will enable people of all ages to experience how their own bodies work and how they are affected by social and environmental influences.

MAX & EVE provides space for projects and solutions with model character, which have a lasting effect on the development of our society. Successful projects will be continued after 2023.





### For the whole of Switzerland

The projects and the exhibition will be conducted in four languages (DE, FR, IT, EN) and are aimed at all sections of our population. We place a special focus on children (including schools), families, people with social, mental or physical disabilities and the "silver agers".

### The name: MAX & EVE

MAX & EVE stands for YOU & ME, for everyone. Health and medicine concerns us all. Doctors, nurses or even you yourself can be a coach when advice or help is needed. MAX & EVE are short names that work independently of language, and they stand for all of us.





# Integrated, innovative project over 4 years

The MAX & EVE World of experience is a national event with the aim of launching various long-term projects to strengthen health literacy. These include projects for schools, families, communities, companies, "silver agers" or for people with disabilities.

Some long-term projects will start as early as 2020, long before the exhibition. All projects are working towards preparing for the mobilizing experience of 2023. Successful projects will continue after the end of the exhibition.

## **Examples of long-term projects**

#### Knowledge platform

As a platform for knowledge the internet is flooded with information of differing levels of quality. Whether it is good or bad is not discernible. In addition, the paid information appears first and has sales-driven views. Without high-quality, comprehensible and transparent information on medicine and health people cannot develop good health literacy.

#### **Magic Food**

Many original home remedies have been lost over the years. These however are a valuable and cheaper alternative for common aliments than expensive medicine.

We would like to make this knowledge available to all people with a free app. Which foods will relieve my cough? What should I cook during the flu season to activate my family's immune system? Which food combinations help me lose weight? A Magic Food guide with (where possible) scientific expertise and without ideological or financial interests. This is the Magic Food project.






# **Share of financing in percent**
